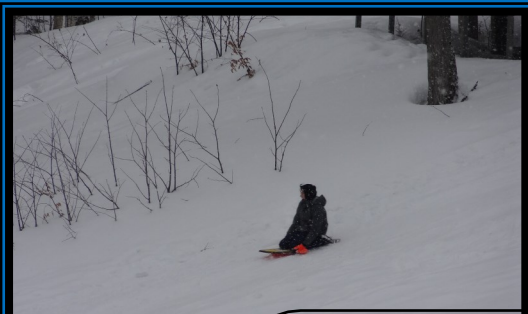


SCHEDULE

Please arrive at the camp between 7:00 pm and 8:15 pm on Friday, March 2nd. You may pull up in front of the main building to unload and there will be someone there to direct you to the dorm and where to park your car. Check out is on Sunday, March 4th between 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm.

Orientation will begin at 8:30 PM sharp.

Campers must be 18 years and above.
Transportation to the camp is your responsibility.



LODGING

We provide lodging in a dorm-style setting. You will need to provide your own bedding (i.e. sleeping bag or single sheet and blanket, pillow, towels and personal necessities).

CANCELLATION POLICY

A full refund less the non-refundable deposit will be issued for cancellations received by fax / mail before Friday February 23, 2018. Substitutions are permitted with written notice.

DIRECTIONS

The Ontario Camp of the Deaf is located ten miles south of Parry Sound, about a three hour drive from Toronto. Take Highway 400 North, and then continue to Highway 69. You will pass an exit to highway 141 to Huntsville. Take the next exit, # 213 to Old Highway 69 South. Turn Right; go down the hill to the first right. Turn right onto BLACKSTONE AND CRANE LAKE ROAD and follow the signs for 5 km to the Ontario Camp of the Deaf.
