American Sign Language (ASL) is native language of Deaf Individuals in North America. The Bob Rumball Canadian Centre of Excellence for the Deaf offer classes in ASL, as a second language. Our courses are non-accredited, interest classes. However, to progress among the levels, students must receive Satisfactory Standing. We do not give out official Income Tax receipts but you can always contact Revenue Canada for further information

**CURRICULUM:** BRCCED uses a curriculum called “Signing Naturally”. Signing Naturally uses a functional notional approach. With this approach, the language you learn is the language used in everyday conversation. By learning language functions in interactive contexts, you also develop conversational skills in confirming and correcting information, expressing degrees of uncertainty, asking for clarification and repetition. Our classes operate in ASL immersion style no-voice environment. This means that you will be asked to keep your voice turned off during your classes.

**Fingerspelling Level 1, 2 & 3** - Deaf Individuals often fingerspell words and names which have no signs. Improve your receptive and expressive fingerspelling skills in these courses.

**Classifiers** - Improve your ability to show movement, location and appearance when signing. Classifiers are handy, simple, wonderful and fun linguistic tools!!

**MINIMUM AGE:** Students from GRADE NINE and up can register for our courses.

**PAYMENT:** Full payment for the course and materials can be made by cash, VISA, MASTERCARD or money order. **Money Orders payable to: BRCCED.** Registration is on a first come, first served basis.

**WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS:** A written request to withdraw must be received by Sign Language Services, before the second class, for a partial refund of course fees. Requests received after the second class will not be accepted. Letters can be faxed to Sign Language Services or dropped off in the Sign Language Services Drop Box. Fees will be refunded, less an administration fee of \$20.00 per student. **Workbooks and DVDs are non-refundable. All refunded fees will be reimbursed with a cheque. Please allow 3—6 weeks for processing and mail delivery of refund cheques.**

**COURSE CANCELLATION:** Courses may be cancelled if an insufficient number of students enroll. Every effort will be made to notify students by phone or e-mail. A full refund will be made for cancelled courses. Please allow 3—6 weeks for processing and mail delivery.

**COMPLETION OF LEVEL / ASL PROGRAM:** Students who pass the dialogue test at the end of each level will receive a letter of Standing. Upon successful completion of each Signing Naturally Curriculum Level One (ASL 1A to ASL 1D) & Level Three (ASL 3A to ASL 3F) graduates will receive a Certificate of Achievement. **You will receive a report card by e-mail.**
