SCHEDULE

Please arrive at the camp between 7:00 pm and 8:15 pm on Friday, May 3rd. You may pull up in front of the main building to unload and there will be someone there to direct you to the dorm and where to park your car. Check out is on Sunday, May 5th between 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm.

DIRECTIONS

The Ontario Camp of the Deaf is located ten miles south of Parry Sound, about a three hour drive from Toronto. Take Highway 400 North, and then continue to Highway 69. You will pass an exit to highway 141 to Huntsville. Take the next exit, # 213 to Old Highway 69 South. Turn Right; go down the hill to the first right. Turn right onto **BLACKSTONE AND CRANE LAKE ROAD** and follow the signs for 5 km to the Ontario Camp of the Deaf.
