WHAT IS ASL?

American Sign Language (ASL) is the native language of Deaf individuals in North America. The Bob Rumball Canadian Centre of Excellence offers classes for those who want to learn ASL as a second language.

WHAT CURRICULUM IS USED?

BRCCED uses a curriculum called "Signing Naturally." With its functional notional approach, you will be learning the language used in everyday conversation. By learning language functions in interactive contexts, you also develop conversational skills in:

- Confirming and correcting information;
- Expressing degrees of uncertainty;
- Asking for clarification; and
- Repetition

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Any student in Grade Nine or above can register for any of our classes by:

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Courses may be cancelled if there are insufficient numbers. Students will be notified by phone or email.

Students will receive a letter of Standing upon passing each level's dialogue test. Upon successful completion of each Signing Naturally Curriculum Level One & Level Three will receive a certificate of Achievement. Report cards for each course will be issued via email.

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OUR PROGRAMS + FACILITIES

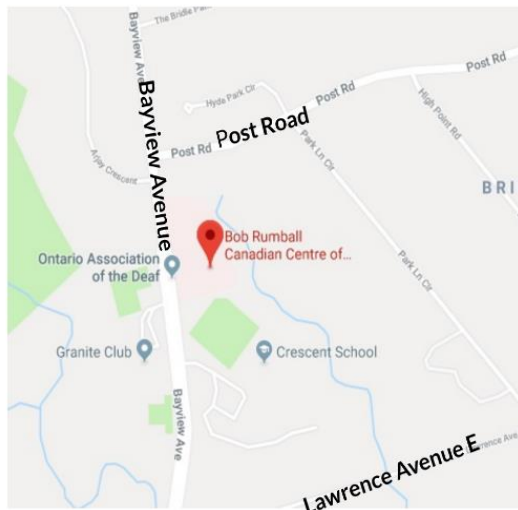
Our programs and courses are non-accredited.

To foster ASL skills development and an appreciation of the Deaf community, our classes and programs operate in an ASL-immersion, “no voice” environment. This means that you will be asked to keep your voice turned off during your classes. 0% voice. 100% ASL.

In our ASL Course Calendar, you will notice that there are no dates/times offered for ASL Level 2. This is because BRCCED no longer offers Signing Naturally Level 2.

Other Deaf organizations are making the same changes and only offering Signing Naturally Level 1 and Level 3. They are no longer teaching Level 2. You are not losing any teaching of ASL with these revisions. Signing Naturally is simply condensing the curriculum. If you have completed Level 1D, you are prepared to take Level 3A.

OUR LOCATION



All classes are held at BRCCED (2395 Bayview Avenue), one light south of Post Road.

If coming by TTC, go to the Davisville Subway Station. Transfer to the Bayview 11 bus heading north to Steeles.

Our facilities are wheelchair accessible.
